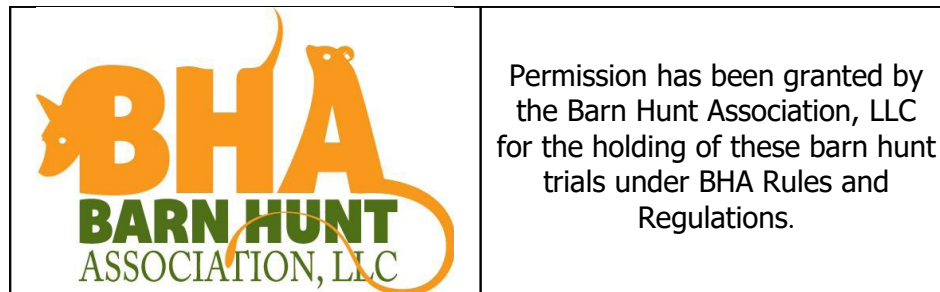

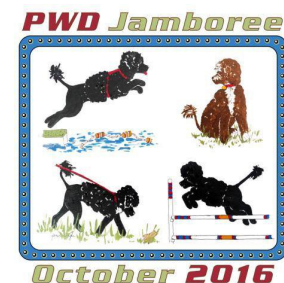

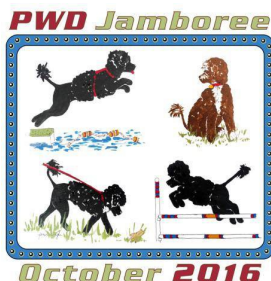

Dr. Kathy Jordan DVM, Crossroads Animal Hospital, 8409 W Oak Hwy, Seneca, SC!

1. Start out going north on High Falls Rd toward Waterfall Rd. Then 1.22 miles
2. Turn sharp right onto Pickens Hwy/SC-183. Continue to follow SC-183. Then 3.60 miles
3. Stay straight to go onto Rochester Hwy/SC-130. Continue to follow SC-130. Then 8.57 miles
4. SC-130 becomes W North 1st St/US-76 Bus W/US-123 Bus S. Then 0.10 miles
5. Turn left onto N Oak St/SC-59. Continue to follow SC-59. Then 6.33 miles
6. Turn slight left onto Cross Roads Dr. Then 0.41 miles
7. Take the 2nd right to stay on Cross Roads Dr. Then 0.02 miles
8. Turn right onto W Oak Hwy/SC-24. Then 0.23 miles
9. Crossroads Animal Hospital, 8409 W OAK HWY is on the right.

AWARDS:

Qualifying ribbon given for dog's first pass in the instinct test. Ribbons will be awarded for first through fourth place in Novice, Open, Senior, Master classes in each height division. Ribbons will be awarded for all qualifiers in the regular classes. New Title Rosettes will be awarded to those who qualify for them.

Move-ups will be allowed but must be made before the class you are moving to ends.

Family Pet Obedience School, LLC reserves the right to refuse any entry for any reason. You will be notified by email and your entry fee will be returned.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Barn Hunt Regulations may be obtained on the website, www.barnhunt.com
- Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- **Entries made without fees, barn hunt number or signature will not be accepted.**
- Dogs will not necessarily be run in height order. Dogs being handled by the same person will be separated into different staged groups.
- All trials will be held out doors within the confines of the tennis court. The blind will be a 10x 20 popup canopy.
- Any dog of any breed or mix, six months of age or older, may participate in Barn Hunt Trials. The only limitation is that the dog must be able to fit through an 18" wide by approximately 22" high "tunnel" made of straw/hay bales.
- Bitches in season (BIS) MAY compete at Barn Hunt trials. They will be run at the end of each class. They must wear pants/britches at all times when not being pottied, including on the course. Owners of BIS **should crate/confine their dogs away from traffic and other dogs, should post "dog in season" signs on their crate/in their area, and potty the dog away from other competitors.** Owners of BIS should make their condition known to the Trial Secretary prior to arrival, if possible. Entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded until closing time of the trial if you wish to withdraw. After the trial closes, entry fees will not be refunded
- Height Divisions: Small, Dogs 13" & under; Medium, Dogs 13.1" to 18"; Large, Dogs over 18". Dogs are measured at the option of the judge.
- Possessing or training with personal, live quarry is not permitted on the show grounds at any time.
- The use of flexi-leads on the show grounds is not permitted during show hours.
- Exhibitors are responsible to clean up after their dogs.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being ready to go to the blind area, and waiting for the call to the gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. The club has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.
- **Your failure to be in the blind or staging area when called will result in a forfeited run.**
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms.
- Please make sure your crate is secure as the dogs may be highly excited. If your dog is overly excited, please do not leave him/her unattended.
- Family Pet Obedience School, LLC officers and members, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs, property, or children.
- Family Pet Obedience School, LLC reserves the right to refuse any entry for any reason. You will be notified by email and your entry fee will be returned.
- **A FEE OF \$7.00 PER BALE WILL BE ASSESSED YOUR DOG MARKS A BALE OF STRAW**

Scribe – responsible for writing down time, faults, obstacles completed on the scribe sheet (easier than it sounds)

RatWrangler – responsible for removing the rat tube from the course if needed so the dog can finish obstacles (Inside rat wrangler and outside rat wrangler are needed)

Leash/Sheet Runner – accepts the leash and collar from handler and places near exit/takes group sheets to secretary; opens and closes gate for handler

Blind Steward – responsible for calling groups into blind and getting dogs to the course when called.

Course Builder – responsible for building and maintaining the courseto the design specified by the Judge.
